# SHOVEL EARLY AND OFTEN



### SELECT THE CORRECT PRODUCT

Salt only works when <u>pavement</u> temperature is above 15°F. (use a temperature gun to check). In colder temperatures, use different products.



## **SCATTER SALT SPARINGLY**

Space salt granules 2 to 3 inches apart.



**SWEEP UP & RE-USE EXCESS SALT**
