- II. Learning Presentation (1 hour) Dr. Lee Frelich, Director of the UMN Center for Forest Ecology Temperature of the soil increased 8F by midsummer because of missing leaf litter insulation. Worsens effects of droughts; digested leaf litter is a source of CO2. Jumping worms move around in mulch-survive winter exclusively as eggs or cocoons; they live in top 2" of soil. Buckthorn removal shred the stump. Put in seeds of native pants.
