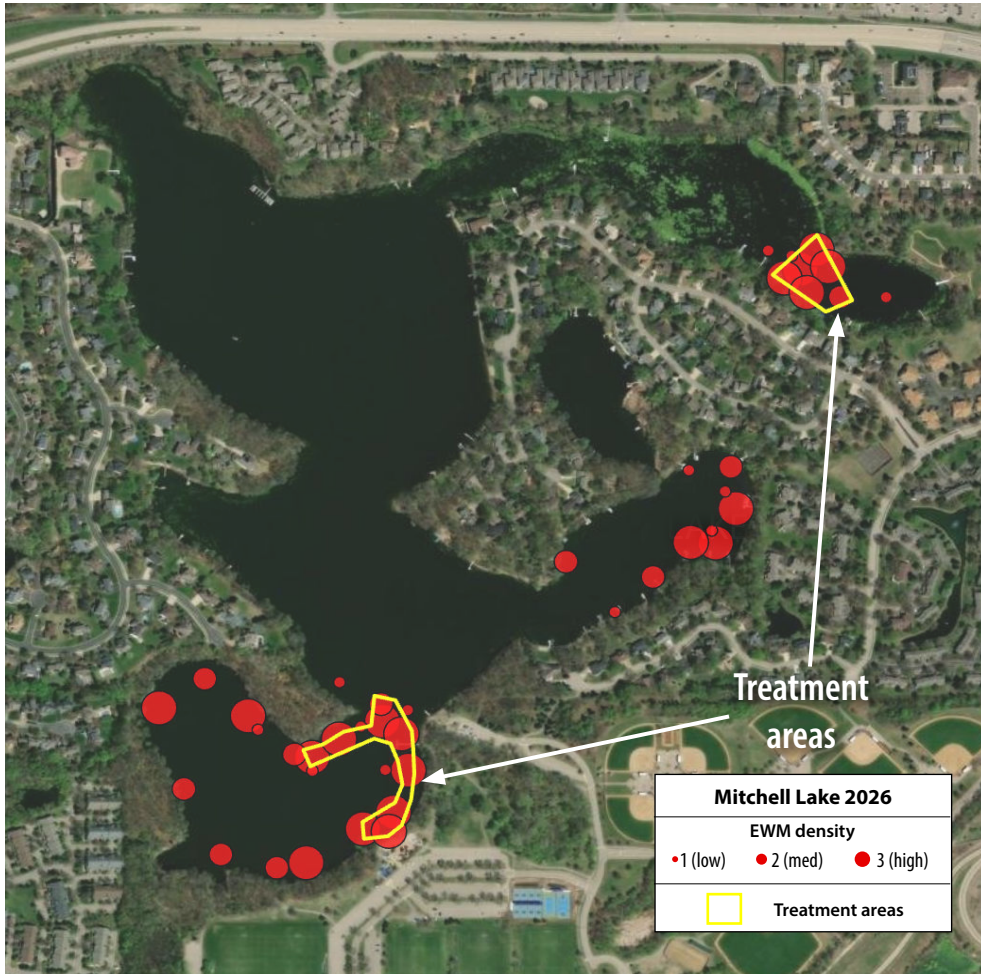


Mitchell Lake 2026 Herbicide Treatment

RPBCWD will use an approved aquatic herbicide to control **Eurasian Watermilfoil (EWM)**, an invasive aquatic plant, pending Minnesota DNR permit approval. See map for treatment area locations. RPBCWD will hire an experienced contractor to apply aquatic herbicide to the lake. ***The treatment will occur at no cost to residents.***



WATER USE RESTRICTIONS

After a **ProcellaCOR** treatment, the DNR recommends not using the water near/within treatment areas for these activities for these number of days:



Swimming
No restriction



Drinking
No restriction



Irrigation

Treatment size is limited by the DNR. The treatment will target areas with the highest density of Eurasian Watermilfoil.

The total treatment size on Lake Riley will be 3.36 acres (updated 7/10/2026).
