Pesticides cause cancer, neurological disorders, reproductive and developmental issues, and endocrine disruptions effecting thyroid function, fertility, and metabolism. There are also many other methods that will not harm the environment and could actually help the soil and tame down the buckthorn. You could use competitive native plantings to shade it out and biological controls like specific fungi to prevent regrowth. To successfully remove buckthorn without harsh chemicals, you must first weaken the existing plants through mechanical methods and then "crowd" the soil with aggressive native species to prevent re-invasion. Allowing toxic compounds to leach into the groundwater is also an extreme fiscal liability: historical data proves that aquifer remediation is a multi-million-dollar, decades-long engineering burden that local taxpayers should never have to foot. While city officials have verbally stated they do not currently spray this site, a temporary policy is not enough to safeguard our future. As the explosive growth of industrial data centers places unprecedented consumption strain on Minnesota's broader groundwater resources, protecting the absolute purity of our remaining public springs is an urgent, non-negotiable duty.
