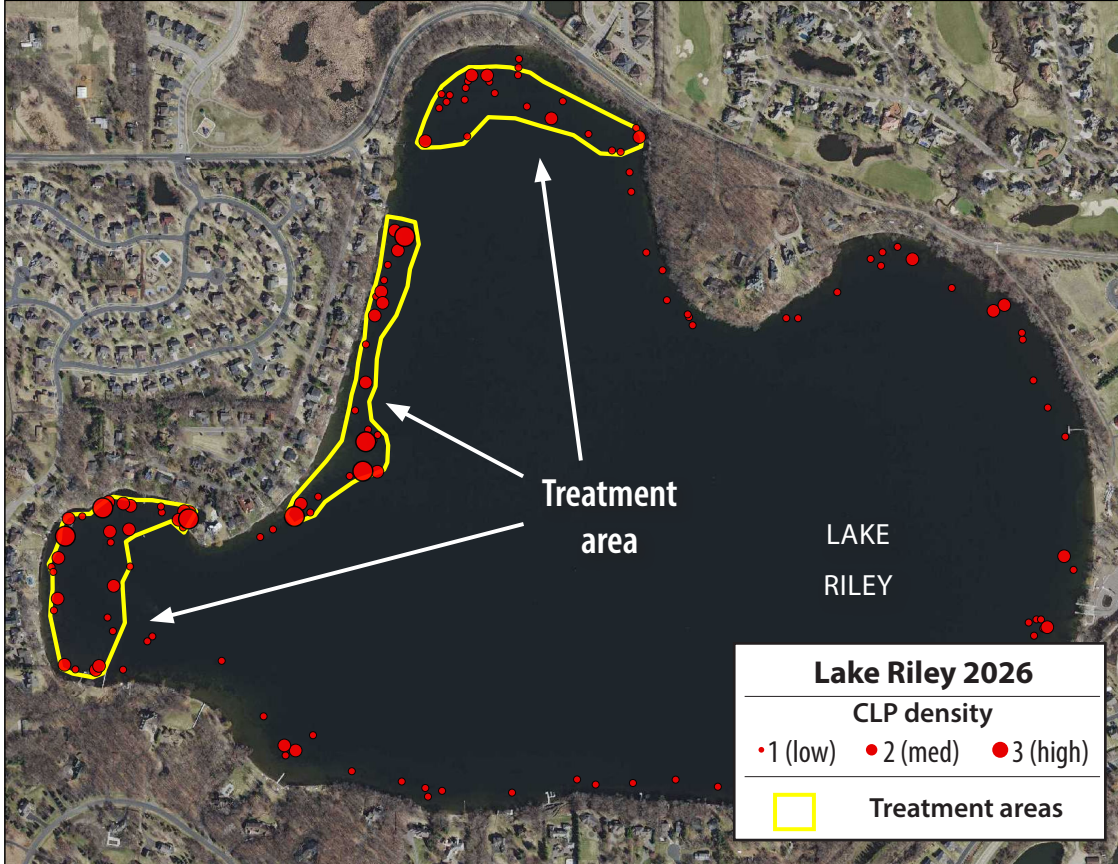


Lake Riley 2026 Herbicide Treatment

RPBCWD received a permit from the Minnesota DNR to control Curly-leaf Pondweed (CLP), an invasive aquatic plant, using an approved aquatic herbicide. See map for treatment area locations. RPBCWD will hire a experienced contractor to apply aquatic herbicide to the lake.

The treatment will occur at no cost to residents.



Treatment:

Week of May 4th

Subject to change due to weather.

What: Herbicide treatment (Flumioxazin)

Where: Within designated area(s) on lake (*see map*)


Why: To control Curly-leaf Pondweed, an invasive aquatic plant


When: **Week of May 4th** (subject to change due to weather)

Treatment size is limited by the DNR. The treatment will target areas with the highest density of Curly-leaf Pondweed.

The total treatment size on Lake Riley will be 19.95 acres.
