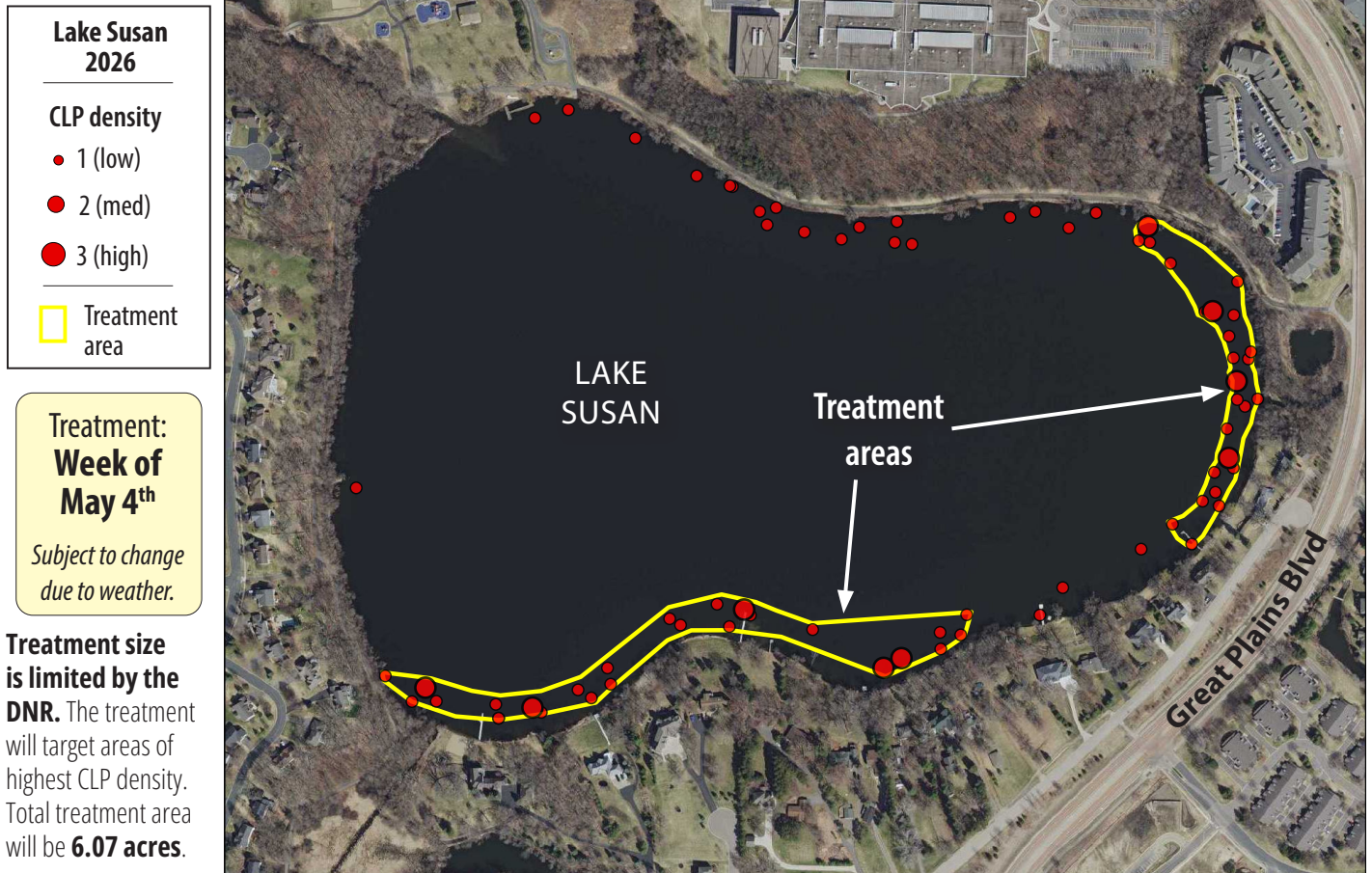


Lake Susan 2026 Herbicide Treatment

RPBCWD received a permit from the Minnesota DNR to control Curlyleaf Pondweed (CLP), an invasive aquatic plant, using an approved aquatic herbicide. See map below for treatment areas.



RPBCWD has hired a contractor to apply an aquatic herbicide to control Curly-leaf Pondweed in the lake. **The treatment will occur at NO COST to residents.**

What: Herbicide treatment (Endothall)

Where: Within designated area(s) on lake (*see map*)

Why: To control Curlyleaf Pondweed, an invasive aquatic plant

When: **Week of May 4th** (subject to change due to weather)

Water Use Restrictions: After an Endothall treatment, the DNR recommends **not using the water** near treatment areas for these activities for these number of days:



Swimming
No restriction



Drinking
3 days



Irrigation
7 days
