BOARD OF MANAGERS

Awarding 2026 Aquatic Invasive Species Management to PLM

Manager Nelson offered the following resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by Manager Duevel.

WHEREAS the duly adopted Riley-Purgatory-Bluff Creek Watershed District (the District) Ten-Year Plan includes a stated goal to “preserve and enhance habitat important fish, waterfowl, and other wildlife”, and

WHEREAS the District has been conducting surveys and treatments of aquatic invasive species annually since adoption of the current Ten-Year Plan, and

WHEREAS quotes were solicited and received from three lake service providers, and

WHEREAS PLM provided the lowest aggregate quote that did not deviate from the recommended treatment protocol.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Riley-Purgatory-Bluff Creek Watershed District Board of Managers awards the 2026 management of aquatic invasive species to PLM as the lowest overall qualified quote

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Board of Managers authorizes the Administrator, with advice of Counsel, to enter into an agreement with PLM to provide these services.

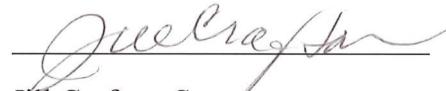
Upon vote, President Pedersen declared the resolution adopted.
